

Passive Income Worksheet

Passive Income is something every small business owner should factor into his or her business plan. It allows you to truly work "smarter, not harder".

In fact, you should soon become an expert at making yourself work less.

No income is truly one hundred percent passive – at least, not when you're starting out (and definitely not within the first year). You can "set", but your passive income will dry up if you truly "forget". Tracking, tweaking, seeing what works and what didn't are all part of the learning curve that every single online entrepreneur experiences. But invest that time into your Passive Income and you'll experience a growing degree of freedom as it begins to work for you.

This series of questions will quickly help you discover which type of Passive Income marketing would be a good addition to your current business (or a complete and fulfilling business in its own right.
